

Public Services Committee Meeting Minutes
July 6, 2010

Chairman Kohlenberg called the meeting to order at 6:55 PM.

2. Consider/recommend Repealing §7.016(3) and §7.05 of the Municipal Code Relating to Parking

Frye reported that on June 1st Council postponed this ordinance amendment until July 6th. The original ordinance included an amendment to §7.03(8)(a)(4) that dealt with parking across a sidewalk. Due to Council's action to not extend the sidewalks on Blain Street and Chaffee Road, this item has been removed. The remaining two are items no longer applicable. §7.016(3) sets the speed limit on Lincoln Court at 15 miles per hour and should be repealed because Lincoln Court is no longer a City Street and §7.05 allows for the operation of motor vehicles in the alley between Chase Bank and May Garden Center and should be repealed as the alley is now a pedestrian way only.

Motion by Hall to recommend repealing §7.016(3) and §7.05 relating to parking; second by Miller. The Committee questioned how long vehicles were allowed in the area between Chase Bank and May Garden Center. Chapman responded over 50 years. Frye stated that small pedestrian gates have been in place for several years. The Committee requested that a sign reading "Motor Vehicles Not Allowed" be attached to the gates before the ordinance takes effect. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Miller to adjourn; second by Hall. Motion carried 3-0. The meeting adjourned at 7:00 PM.
