Do you want to pay your taxes online with a credit card or e-check?

Do you want to make a payment and receive a receipt today.....
but don't want to stand in line at City Hall?

To make an online payment follow these simple instructions

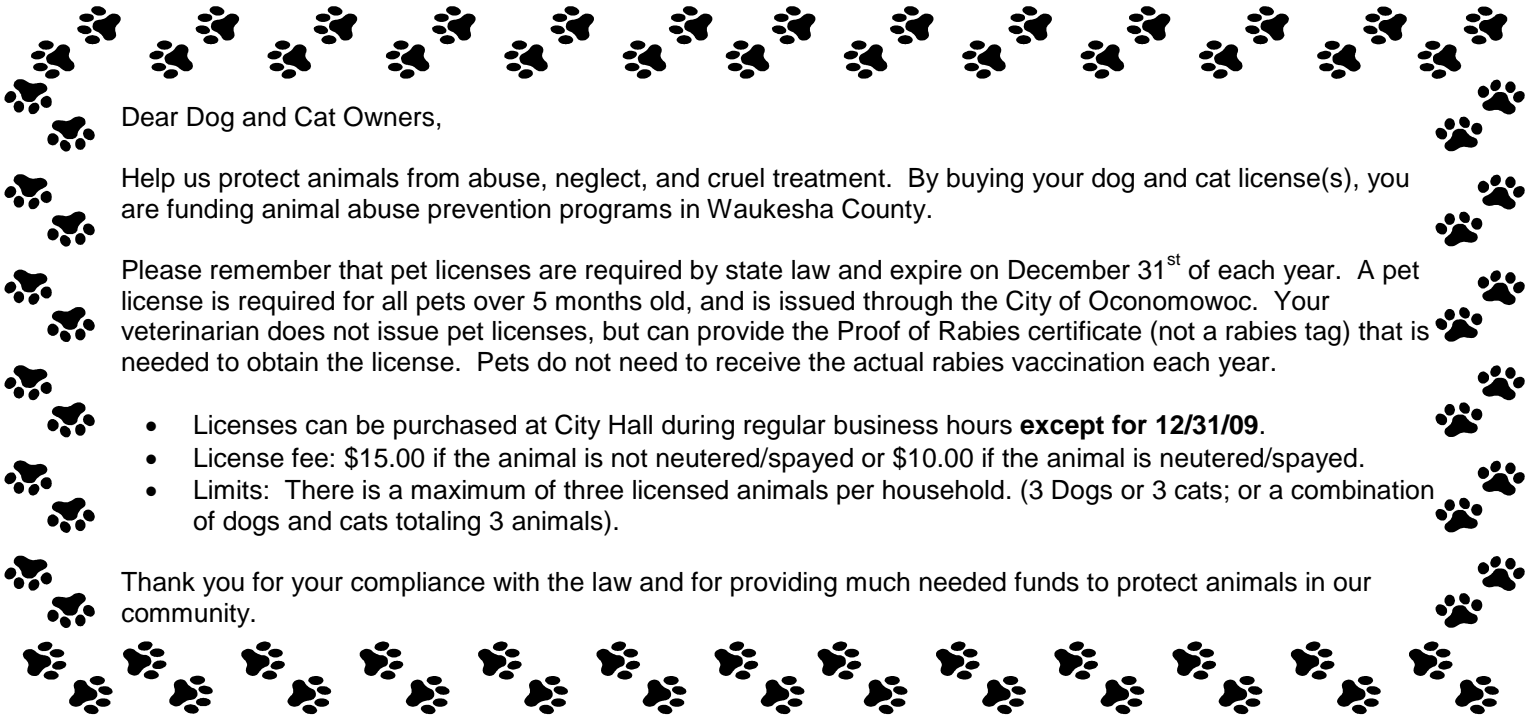
1. Go to www.oconomowocusa.com and click on the link to pay property taxes online
2. Click on "Pay your Taxes Online"
3. Search for your property using the tax key number listed on your tax bill (ex: OCOC0563251)
4. Select your payment option and follow the instructions to make your payment and print your receipt



Important Notice: A service fee will be assessed by the third party provider to the taxpayer

Credit card payments – 3% of payment

E-checks – \$1 flat fee



Dear Dog and Cat Owners,

Help us protect animals from abuse, neglect, and cruel treatment. By buying your dog and cat license(s), you are funding animal abuse prevention programs in Waukesha County.

Please remember that pet licenses are required by state law and expire on December 31st of each year. A pet license is required for all pets over 5 months old, and is issued through the City of Oconomowoc. Your veterinarian does not issue pet licenses, but can provide the Proof of Rabies certificate (not a rabies tag) that is needed to obtain the license. Pets do not need to receive the actual rabies vaccination each year.

- Licenses can be purchased at City Hall during regular business hours **except for 12/31/09**.
- License fee: \$15.00 if the animal is not neutered/spayed or \$10.00 if the animal is neutered/spayed.
- Limits: There is a maximum of three licensed animals per household. (3 Dogs or 3 cats; or a combination of dogs and cats totaling 3 animals).

Thank you for your compliance with the law and for providing much needed funds to protect animals in our community.
